Dear Friend in Christ,

Once upon a time, people used to celebrate the season before Christmas in a very different way than we do today. The time before Christmas – Advent – was considered a "penitential" season – a time very much like Lent. No decorations, no Christmas carols, no festive foods. The hymns were slow and mournful. Then, in the midst of all this bleakness, there was the "Sunday of Joy" – the third Sunday in Advent. The other Advent wreath candles are purple – the color of repentance and a somber mood. But when Advent was halfway through, the one candle was pink – the color of joy. For this one day, people were permitted to sing and dance, to eat festive foods, and generally celebrate that Advent was half over, and that Christmas was on the horizon.

It all seems pretty hard to imagine now, doesn't it? Stores put out Christmas stuff in September. Christmas carols start up on the radio the day before Thanksgiving. I observed the English tradition of Candlemas (February 2) as the official conclusion of the Christmas season. Care to join me?)

In any case, it's Joy Sunday. Today is the day to remember that the birth of Jesus is our joy. It's a day to remember that, in the midst of all our big preparations and Christmas lists, we have a connection to God to celebrate. Remember? It's the reason for the season! Yes, joy to the world! Because – the Lord has come.

I hope you take a moment to be still and to remember that, even in the midst of everything you may be going through this Christmas, Jesus is still your best heavenly Friend. I hope that thought brings you joy this Sunday – and always
