From the Generosity Team:

Dear Supportive Friend,

Thank you to all who have contributed to our Church! Special thanks to those who have contributed over and above what you were planning on giving to the church. However, we are still significantly behind where we need to be at this time of year.

As we enter the 4th quarter of the year, there is still time to think and act upon some tax strategies that can reduce your taxes and help the church.

First, if you are taking **required minimum distributions** (RMD) from a traditional IRA and have not met your RMD for the year, a qualified charitable distribution is a great way to meet your RMD without incurring taxes. The distribution will have to go directly to the charity, in their name, so that you will not incur the taxes.

Secondly, if you are older than seventy and a half and not taking RMDs, you can still do a qualified charitable distribution from a traditional IRA, again tax free. Again, the distribution has to go directly to the charity in their name.

If you are taking RMDs, please familiarize yourself with the tax considerations involved.

Third, if you have established a "donor advised fund", the church is considered an eligible charitable organization and would greatly appreciate any distribution from it.

you understand all the pros and cons associated with any distribution either from a traditional IRA or a donor advised fund before doing anything.

Also, please mark on your calendar November 30th - Giving Tuesday - which is another great day to make a special contribution to the church.

And – stay tuned to this column next week, when we'll be announcing the title and theme of our end of year generosity campaign!
